

To All Pet Owners,

Please be cautious!!!

In recent months, we have received multiple reports about a man, believed to be employed at the NTT Docomo Media Tower, who has abruptly shouted at residents walking their dogs along the path between the condominium and the Media Tower during the hours of 8:15 AM to 8:45 AM.

Additionally, in light of recent incidents where this individual attempted to kick dogs, we consulted with the police, who have issued a warning and provided guidance to him. We kindly ask that you remain vigilant when walking your dogs during this time, especially on the Media Tower premises.

The police have advised that if similar incidents occur, it is important to report them as necessary. At the same time, we would greatly appreciate it if you could also share this information with the Pet Committee using the suggestion box located on the first floor.

It appears that part of the underlying issue may relate to an incident in which a pet owner allowed their dog to relieve itself on the Media Tower premises without proper cleanup.

Moreover, we have received the following complaints within our condominium, indicating that some rules are not being adhered to:

- Dogs being walked in the building without prior permission.
- Dogs relieving themselves on the second-floor wood deck.
- Pets relieving themselves in the dog run without cleanup afterward.
- A persistent odor of urine in the dog run.

To address these concerns, we will be posting the "Pet Ownership Rules" on the bulletin board located on the first floor. We encourage all pet owners to take this opportunity to review these rules and reflect on their behavior while walking their pets. Attached is a map indicating areas within the condominium premises where pet relief is prohibited. Your cooperation in adhering to these rules and acting responsibly as pet owners is greatly appreciated for the well-being of your beloved pets.
